

Thank you for using Woodhouse Activity Centre for your camp.

Woodhouse is proudly owned and operated by Scouts SA.

We have only one “Rule” at Woodhouse – Rule Number 1: “HAVE FUN”!

We do however ask that you help us care for our environment and for the safety of all visitors by accepting a few simple responsibilities.

1. **Speed limit** within Woodhouse is **15kph**. Normal road rules apply.
2. **Parking:** Park with consideration for others. Do not block roadways, entrances to accommodation centres, and the amenities buildings. We **MUST** keep access clear for Emergency Vehicle access.
3. **Fires** are permitted in designated fireplaces only. Open flames, including **SMOKING & wood &/or gas BBQ's**, are totally prohibited during fire ban season. Please ensure people in your care are made aware of safety issues involving fires and BBQ's.
4. **Camp Sites** should be selected with great care – trees can fall or drop large limbs without warning. Tents must not be placed under any trees whatsoever.
5. **Amenities:** Amenities Shelters are, at all times, shared facilities with all other persons onsite.
6. **Recycling bins** are for cans, bottles, tins and jars. Keep cardboard or newspaper separate and flattened
7. **Music, Bands & General Noise:** No music permitted without prior written managers authorization. At all times, consideration must be given to other persons staying on the property and to Woodhouse neighbours. No amplified music & no bands allowed. All music must cease by 10pm, no exceptions. Earlier times may be advised by management.
8. **Smoking, Smoke Machines, Steam, Candles & Aerosols:** are prohibited inside & outside all buildings due to the sensitive nature of the smoke alarms. A call out can result in a \$600 fee charged to the group by the CFS.
9. **Pets:** no pets, including dogs, are permitted on Woodhouse.
10. **Snakes:** Be aware of reptiles during the warmer months – there are many snakes in the area, so ensure all members of your group know to take appropriate care and wear shoes at all times.
11. **Activities:** When conducting outdoor activities, please ensure that your group respects the privacy of other campers & users of the accommodation centres. Ensure your activities do not invade their space.
12. **Challenge Hill:** All persons wishing to use Challenge Hill **MUST** book a Safety Talk from the Warden before starting the course. All groups must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult. Challenge Hill may only be used whilst a Warden is on duty, 9.30-5 when dry only.

13. **Breakages & Leaks:** must be notified to the Duty Warden. **DO NOT** attempt to carry out repairs yourself.
14. **Gas BBQs:** Gas bottles are refilled by the Duty Warden. Please contact the warden if empty.
15. **Personal Safety:** Be sunsafe. Wear appropriate footwear. Have a suitable First Aid Kit at hand at all times.
16. **Top Bunks:** Children under 6 years, bed-wetters and sleep walkers should not sleep on top bunks.
