

Lightstrike Mobile Laser Tag COVID-19 Playspace Management Plan July, 2020

PURPOSE

Further to post COVID-19 restrictions being lifted, Lightstike Mobile Laser Tag has adopted the following action plan and guidelines for the facilitation and playing of laser tag games. This plan does not take into account specific site plans that may be in place at any play location, but focuses on Lightstrike's individual actions in response to managing exposure.

OBJECTIVES

- To manage, and maintain a safe workplace environment for employees of Lightstrike.
- To provide a safe environment for patrons of Lightstrike and any other workers of the play site.
- To establish a method of controls to manage procedures regarding day to day operations of Lightstrike.

REVIEW PERIOD

This document and the procedures here in shall be monitored and updated on a monthly basis. If required, should any escalation of the states COVID 19 status change, this document will be updated a.s.a.p.

PROCEDURE

As a general declaration, Lightstrike is governed by all legislation and restrictions prescribed by SA Health. Activity can be conducted indoors and outdoors in small groups, providing that 1 person per $1.5m^2$ is abided by.

Preparation, precautions and on arrival proceedures

- Guests should not attend if they are unwell (even mildly unwell).
- Guests are required to sign an attendance register COVID-19 aware statement on arrival and a COVID awareness waiver.
- Guests are encouraged to download the COVID SAFE app on their phones.
- Lightstrike staff will use disinfectant wipes to clean the equipment down prior to patrons handling them.
- All patrons will apply supplied hand sanitizer before handling the equipment.
- Lightstrike staff shall remain at least 1.5m away from patrons at all times, and apply hand sanitizer before and after contact with each group.
- Lightstrike staff will wipe down equipment at the end of each session with disinfectant wipes prior to packing away.

Cleaning

Disinfectant wipes and hand sanitiser will be made available for groups to use to sanitise surfaces and hands. Lightstrike will clean all patron equipment prior to each group.
