The Stirling Golf Course | (right next door to Woodhouse!) 35 Golflinks Rd, Stirling SA 5152 | 8339 1788

One of the great pleasures of playing golf at The Stirling Golf Club is the wonderful course environment. Even if you hit a duffed shot, you can at least take solace in soaking up the natural beauty that surrounds you.

Cleland National Park | 365 Mount Lofty Summit Road, Crafers | 8339 2444

Just 12 kilometres from Adelaide City centre, Cleland Conservation Park conserves a vital area of natural bushland on the Adelaide Hills face and includes the internationally popular Cleland Wildlife Park, the viewing platform of Mt Lofty Summit and scenic Waterfall Gully. The area has a rich history of Aboriginal occupation and European settlement.

Beerenberg Strawberry Farm | Mount Barker Road, Hahndorf | 8388 7272 (18 minute drive)

There's nothing like the taste of freshly picked strawberries. It's hard to describe the juiciness and flavours – you won't get it from any supermarket! And there's no better day out with the family than hunting through our patch to find the perfect strawberry. It's become an Adelaide institution during the warmer months, usually from November to April.

There are many activities for kids at the farm and you can easily spend hours there enjoying quality time with your family.

National Motor Museum | Shannon Street, Birdwood | 8568 4000 (40 minute drive)

The National Motor Museum boasts one of the largest, finest and most important collections of cars, motorcycles and commercial vehicles in the world. The collection comprises over 300 vehicles dating from the turn of the century to the present day. The museum is also the recognised centre for the recording of all aspects of road motor transport history in Australia. It is for this reason, among others, that the National Motor Museum enjoys an international reputation.

The Big Rocking Horse and Toy Factory | 452 Torrens Valley Road, Gumeracha | 8389 1085 (35 minute drive) The Big Rocking Horse and the Toy Factory share the same site at Gumeracha, in the glorious Adelaide Hills, only 40 minutes from Adelaide. So come and visit us for fun, educational value and an experience of a lifetime.

Monarto Zoological Park | Old Princes Highway, Monarto | 8534 4100 (35 minute drive)

1,000 hectare open-range sanctuary undertaking a major role nationally and internationally in breeding programs for rare and endangered species. ATTRACTIONS CONT. & WALKING TOURS

Mt Lofty Botanical Garden | Summit Rd or Piccadilly Rd, Crafers

The crescent-shaped Mount Lofty Botanic Garden is situated on 97 hectares on the eastern slopes of Mount Lofty in the Adelaide Hills east of Adelaide in South Australia. The cooler, wetter location suits plants from temperate climates which are difficult to grow on the Adelaide Plains. Amongst the native Australian flora there are tree ferns, as well as exotic cultivated plants from cool climates including Rhododendron and Magnolia and the National Species Rose Collection.

SAFETY NOTES:

- Hikes should not be attempted on fire ban days or on very windy, or extremely wet days.
- Sections of Heysen trail are closed on fire ban days.
- Carry a mobile phone; service is available at most points along the trails.
- Wear comfortable, enclosed footwear and appropriate clothing including a hat
- Carry a suitable first aid kit.
- Always take water on the hike.
- Beware of snakes in warmer weather

All distances and times are approximate, for small groups and one-way

TO MT GEORGE CONSERVATION PARK 1km/45mins

Follow the Heysen Trail markers to the stile (ladder) over the boundary fence on the eastern side of the property Cross over Carey Gully Rd (with caution) into the Mt Lofty Golf Course Follow the Heysen Trail markers across the creek and continue up the hill The rocky outcrop is on the left of the track at the junction with Woodcutters Track

TO MT LOFTY BOTANICAL GARDENS (open 8.30am-4.00pm) 1.5 kms/30mins

Turn right out the main exit gate onto Spring Gully Rd.

Turn right at the T Junction onto Piccadilly Rd.

Cross to the other side of Piccadilly Rd (with caution) then turn left onto Sprigg Rd.

Veer left onto Lampert Rd to get to Mt Lofty Botanical Gardens.

TO MT LOFTY LOOKOUT TOWER 3kms/ 90mins (1/3 of trail is on roads and the rest is along the Heysen trail) Follow Heysen trail to south west corner of Woodhouse. Over style, turn right into dirt track at Piccadilly Rd.

Cross to the other side of Piccadilly Rd (with caution).

Turn left onto Sprigg Rd and stay on Sprigg Rd.

Just past the Ross Rd turnoff on the right is a sharp bend on Sprigg Rd – find Heysen Trail on the left. Take this steep track and follow the signs to the summit.

TO CLELAND WILDLIFE PARK 4km/2hrs

Follow all the directions to the Mt Lofty Lookout Tower. Once there follow the walking trail towards Cleland. Any troubles, just ask the helpful staff there or follow the signs.
